**The last week of Sunday School** for this education year is Sunday, May 4.

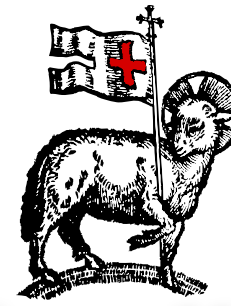
