We will celebrate the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, April 17, at 7pm in our sanctuary. The communion offering is for Hope Cemetery.

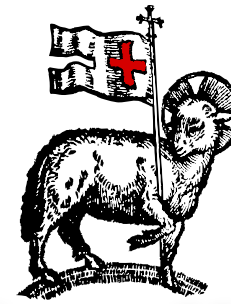
