The Food Packing event on Sunday, September 7, provides meals for school children at UCI in Haiti. For many of these kids, it's their only meal of the day. Our goal is to pack 100,000 meals for them, so lots of volunteers are needed. Invite your neighbor, friends, and family members - all ages can help. Please put your name on the sign-up sheet in the Fellowship Hall so we can plan ahead. Packing shifts are 8:00am, 9:00am and 11:00am; worship service is at 10:00am.

We will be doing a Backpack Blessing for children going into preschool through college age on Sunday, September 7! Please have your children bring their backpacks to church on this day! We have a keychain for their backpacks that we will hand out and will be sharing a prayer and blessing with them for the 2025-2026 school year.
