Mid July, 10 of our high school students went to Chicago to do mission work. Working primarily in the southern suburbs, the group worked with a number of at risk youth and families. The highlight of this trip, however, was getting to distribute blessing bags to the homeless population with supplies donated by members of FRC.

Community COOKOUT

Around 200 people attended our first ever Community Cookout and they sampled nearly 20 different foods, including smoked brisket, fried fish, fried onions, tacos, brats, salads, and desserts! We have amazing cooks! Seven of our local mission partners joined us that evening. They set up displays, gave away gifts, and invited discussions about their ministry!



MEAL PACKING EVENT

For the fourth year in a row, members of our church and community came together for a fun food packing Sunday. In three hours, we packed 100,008 lifesaving, nutritious meals for school children in Haiti. These meals are shipped to our ministry partners JeanJean and Kristie Mompremier at UCI in Haiti. Early on Sunday morning, September 7th, seven mobile food packing stations are set up in the Fellowship Hall of the church and then hundreds of volunteers show up to fill bags with rice, beans, dried vegetables, minerals and vitamins.
