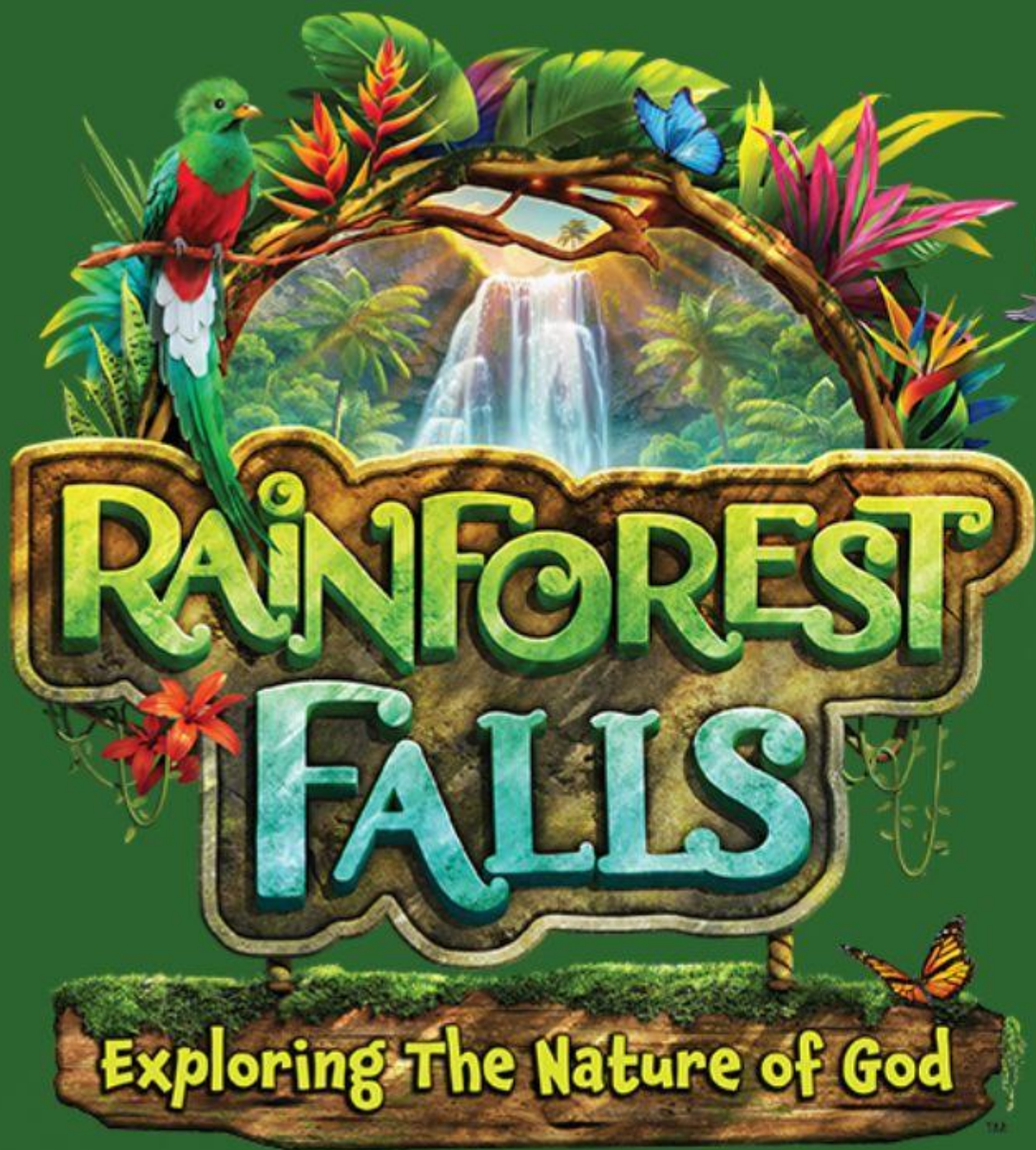

**The cost to produce and ship
the wheelchairs is \$52,000
(about \$250 per wheelchair)**
