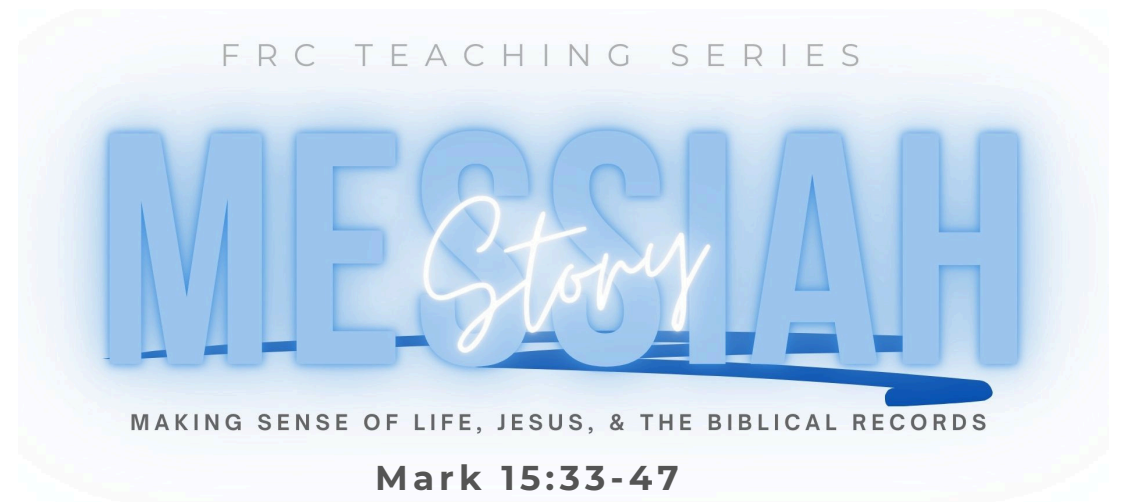
Gently Used Clothing Collection for the Gospel Mission: A large box is in the Fellowship Hall until April 8 for your donations. Any season of clothing accepted.
