January 21 / The Well: Coach Chris Yaw

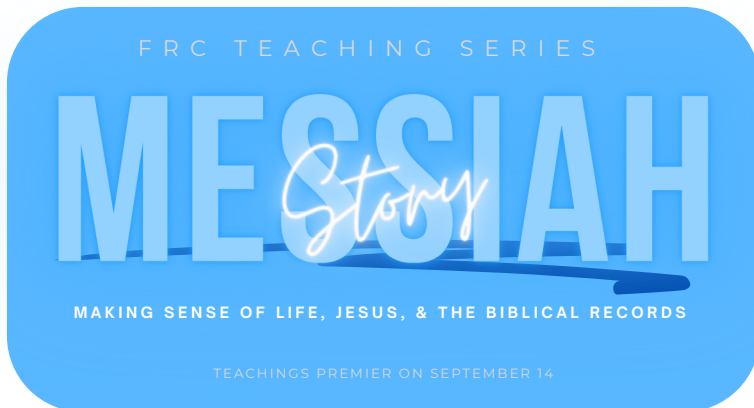
